TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Every entrant must be Affiliated as a Player Member to ETTA Ltd. or be a Member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. ETTA Tournament Regulations apply to this tournament). ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply except those relating to the matters covered by items marked (x) in this entry form.
3. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Player Member to ETTA Ltd or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
4. Completion and submission of this entry form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition including variations from the ITTF requirements, and to the storage of information about the competitor on a computer system.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. All events will be played as 3 rounds of group matches. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5. The format may be varied at the discretion of the Organisers in the light of entries received.
6. Competitors may enter up to TWO events. Cadets and Seniors competitions will be played in the morning and Juniors in the afternoon.
7. The maximum number of entries for each of the Senior Mens, Cadet Boys and Junior Boys is 36. In the Cadet Girls, Junior Girls and Senior Womens competitions the maximum is 12. Places will be awarded on receipt of applications and payment.
8. Competitors must report to Control on arrival, and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
9. The Committee reserves the right to cancel any event.
10. Competitors will be permitted to practise on match tables at the discretion of Control.
11. All competitors may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.(x)
12. Players' clothing: main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball (see Tournament Information para 7).
13. Doping shall not take place either before or during play.
14. No glueing up will be allowed in the building.
15. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
16. Match results will be submitted for inclusion in the ETTA computer ranking scheme.
17. Competitors must be born in 1997 or later (Cadet) and in 1994 or later (Junior).

TOURNAMENT INFORMATION

1. All entries must be sent to : **Ralph Weeks, 60 Victoria Gardens, Ferndown, Dorset BH22 9JH** by no later than **Monday 19th March 2011** together with a stamped, self-addressed envelope unless email address given.
2. The draw will be held on **Monday 26th March 2012**.
3. If it is necessary to restrict entries, restriction will be on the basis of last received, first out.
4. Competitors will be informed of the times of their opening matches at least 5 days in advance.
5. Light refreshments and changing rooms will be available at the venue, together with ample free parking.
6. Play will take place on up to 24 Butterfly Centrefold and Joola World Cup tables with scoring machines.
7. Play will be with Joola (or similar) 3 star white balls.
8. Tables will be individually courted. Minimum ceiling height 6m, minimum court size 9m x 5m.
9. Lighting is general and is high frequency fluorescent.
10. Play will be on rubberised compound sports flooring.
11. There will be no admission charge.
12. Dope testing may take place.
13. The results from this tournament will qualify for computer ranking points.
14. Trophies will be awarded to winners and runners-up in all events.

Playing Schedule

Each competition will have 3 sessions of group matches. After each session positions will determine the composition of the groups in the next session. Therefore everyone will play AT LEAST six matches and no one will be knocked out.

If in any competition the entry does not reach the minimum number required for this format the organisers will adapt the format as necessary.

DIRECTIONS

From M27/A31

Take the A338 towards Bournemouth. Take the third exit towards Kings Park and Boscombe. At the roundabout at the end of the slip road, turn left into Littledown Avenue. After approximately 400 metres, turn right at the roundabout, third exit, into Harewood Avenue. After 50 metres turn left into the Avonbourne/Portchester campus. Portchester is at the end of the road.

In case of difficulty, it is recommended that you navigate to the flyover/roundabout at the intersection of the A338 and the A3060 near the Hospital and take the A338 (Wessex Way) towards Bournemouth Town Centre. The first exit is then the one referred to above, towards Kings Park and Boscombe.

Please be aware that some Satnavs direct you to the rear of the school grounds, where there is no access. You can avoid this by entering 'Harewood Avenue' into your Satnav though this may take you to the southern end of Harewood and you then just follow it along until you see the sign to Portchester and Avonbourne Schools on your right.
